RCBT-5/87 (Pt-II):: In supercession of this Department Notification No. RCBT-5/87 dated 24th March, 1994*, the Governor of Nagaland, in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 16 (4) of the Constitution of India, hereby directs that 25% of all categories both Gazetted and Non-Gazetted posts under the Government of Nagaland shall be reserved for the persons belonging to the following 6 (six) Tribes of four Districts of Mon, Tuensang, Kiphire and Longleng:-

- 1. Chang
- 2. Khiamniungan
- 3. Konyak
- 4. Phom
- 5. Sangtam
- 6. Yimchunger
- 2. Further, the balance 8% of all categories both Gazetted and Non-Gazetted posts under the Government of Nagaland (out of 33% reservation of posts earlier for the 9 (nine) Backward Tribes) will be reserved for the following Tribes.
 - 1. Chakhesang.
 - 2. Pochury.
 - 3. Zeliang.
- Two new 200 point rosters also with revised instructions on operating the rosters, one
 each for Non-Gazetted and Gazetted (Both Technical and Non Technical posts are
 introduced with immediate effect. All appointments henceforth shall conform to the new
 roster system.
- 4. All Departments should maintain a separate Register for effective implementation of reservation for the Backward Tribes. Further, all the Departments are requested to submit Quarterly reports to this Department and the Department of Underdeveloped Areas (DUDA) of the implementations of the policy.
- 5. In case any difficulty in implementing the provisions of the revised Reservation Policy for BT, the Departments shall refer the matter with relevant records to this Department for clarification.
