Whereas the sportsmen and sportswomen should be given special preference in matter of appointments to posts under the State Government with a view to improving their physical fitness and promoting qualities of sportsmanship and team-spirit among them subject to the condition that they fulfill the requisite qualification and experience prescribed by the Government for each category of the posts:

Now therefore, the State Government of Nagaland has decided to reserve certain percentage of Class-III, IV and Gazetted posts which are non-technical in nature under the State Government for meritorious sportsmen and sportswomen.

Consequent on the decision and in exercise of the power conferred by Article 16 (4) of the constitution of India, the Government of Nagaland reserve 5% Class III and IV posts non-gazetted posts which are non-technical in nature in the Departments of Police and Physical Education only for the local meritorious sportsmen and sportswomen who satisfy the following criteria:-

- (1) Sportsmen who have represented a State or the Country in a National or International State competition in any of the games/ sports mentioned in the annexure to this Notification.
- (2) Sportsmen who have represented their Universities in the Inter-University Tournaments conducted by the Inter-University Sports Board in any of the games/sports mentioned in annexure to this Notification.
- (3) Sportsmen who have represented the State School Games Federation in any of the Games/Sports mentioned in annexure to this Notification.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
